

Weakly bonded old snow is to be evaluated with care and prudence. Further increase in danger of wet avalanches as a consequence of warming during the day.

Weak layers in the old snowpack can still be released in some places by individual winter sport participants. Caution is to be exercised in particular at transitions from a shallow to a deep snowpack, when entering gullies and bowls for example, as well as in little used terrain. Mostly avalanches are medium-sized.

As a consequence of warming during the day, the likelihood of wet avalanches being released will increase in particular on steep sunny slopes below approximately 2600 m.

Backcountry touring calls for meticulous route selection.

Snowpack

Danger Patterns

dp.1: deep persistent weak layer

dp.10: springtime scenario

The old snowpack remains prone to triggering in some places, especially on steep, little used shady slopes above approximately 2200 m, as well as on very steep sunny slopes at elevated altitudes. The weather conditions brought about a slow strengthening of the old snowpack. The snowpack will be subject to considerable local variations. Sunshine and high temperatures will give rise as the day progresses to softening of the snowpack in particular on steep sunny slopes below approximately 2600 m.

Tendency

As a consequence of warming during the day more wet snow slides and avalanches are possible.




Height Profile – Senior MEN




Race Tracks – Senior Men




Height Profile - Senior WOMEN




2nd Transition Area – after the bridge





ISMF Sporting Rules & Regulations (point 4.6)

Abandon

- A competitor having difficulties may give up on his/her own initiative or be forced to give-up by decision of the race director or one of the doctor's present.
- Giving up (by own initiative or forced) must take place at a checkpoint or waypoint according to the procedure described during race Team Captain Meeting except under extreme circumstances. For team races, if one team member gives up then the other will be told to give up and must follow instructions given by the controllers. Every competitor having withdrawn MUST inform the President of Technical Jury (or his representative) upon arrival at the finish area, and especially the Anti-Doping Delegate. The competitors having withdrawn may also be subject to doping control.

Safety along the route is guaranteed by 5 First-Aid Stations, 3 Avalanche Rescue Dogs and 70 Track Attendants of Mountain Rescue, all equipped with Radio! Rescue helicopter approach time to the track: 6-8 minutes
