

The mountains are often covered in clouds and it will already snowing lightly in some areas, especially at the start of the day and in the evening. Snowfall will become more frequent during the night.



Snow Conditions & Avalanche Report



Low <u>avalanche danger</u> will be encountered over a wide area.

The fresh wind slabs can in very isolated cases be released, even by a single winter sport participant, especially on very steep shady slopes above approximately 2400 m. These avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular in gullies and bowls, and behind abrupt changes in the terrain. The prevalence of the avalanche prone locations will increase with altitude. In very isolated cases dry avalanches can also be released in the old snowpack. Avalanche prone locations are to be found in particular in little used terrain above approximately 2400 m, especially on very slopes. Mostly avalanches are small.

Only isolated gliding avalanches are possible.





Individual Race Map and track – Senior Women















Individual Race Height profile – Senior Women







During the European Championships, in the Individual Race, the Race Jury knew for the first time ever that the weight of some jackets, especially women jackets, was not according to the rules (less than 1% of the total weight). This concerns only a special group of athletes (small female athlete with size XS) and not separate individuals.

For many reasons the Race Jury decided not to apply a penalty for this concept.

Now, the referees understand that all coaches and athletes know the existence of this rule, and if there will be another similar situation during the season, the rule will be respected from the Race Jury and the possible penalties applied.

From the Referees Commission there will be a proposal to improve this rule for the season 24/25.

Rules and Guidelines.

Abandon:

- An athlete having difficulties may give up on his/her own initiative or be forced to give-up by decision of the LOC Race Director or one of the doctor's present.
- Giving up (by own initiative or forced) must take place at a checkpoint or waypoint according to the procedure described during race TCM except under extreme circumstances. For team races, if one team member gives up then the other will be told to give up and must follow instructions given by the controllers. Every athlete having withdrawn MUST inform the ISMF Jury President (or his representative) upon arrival at the finish area. The athletes having withdrawn may also be subject to doping control.



Safety along the Track



Safety along the route is guaranteed by 5 First-Aid Stations, 3 Avalanche Rescue Dogs and 70 Track Attendants of Mountain Rescue, all equipped with Radio! Rescue helicopter approach time, weather permitting, to the track: 6-8 minutes



Car Pass - Shuttle Service



- Due to limited parking space, only a specified number of cars are allowed to park near the Individual Start
- Teams will get a "Green Car Pass" to park at reserved parking space
- Each team will get at least 1 "Green Car Pass". For every 8 athletes the teams get 1 additional "Green Car Pass".
- The **"Yellow Car Pass**" is reserved for ISMF, LOC; the **"Red Car Pass**" is valid for the races on Saturday and Sunday; Please make sure to park in the right area!
- Alternatively, there is a free shuttle service from the Biathlon Centre (no pre-booking needed)
